3. Liability

The event organizers (or any of its officials or members) will not be liable or responsible for any personal injury.

Coaches and team leaders ensure that all participants are physically fit, prepared, and capable of coping with the tournament. We strongly recommend proper medical and accident insurance. Competitors compete at their own risk.

4. Rules and Draw

The following rules apply:

- JJIF competition rules (in their latest versions), Organization and Sporting code of JJIF Version 1.1 (SC2024).¹
- We appeal to all participants to respect the fair-play and JJIF book of ethics

4.1 Draw Modus

The seeding and draw-en-bock will be made on **October 3rd, 2024 at 18:00²**.

Immediately after the draw has been finalized, the categories will be made available online on the Sportdata Event Website. JJNOs have the right to request minor changes in the following 2 hours, in writing, to the organizing committee.

Major changes³ must be requested according to the following⁴:

- At international events, no redraw is possible except for unforeseen cases when the OC may decide on a redraw.
- A redraw can be requested max. two hours after the draw was published, but, in any case, before the start of the competition, in writing, to the OC.

Seeding regulations of the JJIF will be observed for Adults division. For the seeding, JJIF will use the world ranking list and registration for the event from **September 22th, 2024**. The JJNOs are responsible for making sure all points are correct in the raking list until this day.

4.2 Appeal and Challenge

5. Right to Participate and Categories

Based on the JJIF SC2023 1.0 § 2.3.2. Entries of Competitors:

There's no maximum number of contestants in each category the JJNO's can register in international ranked events. The organizing committee can close the registrations earlier if the event reach its maximum capacity.

5.1 Disciplines

- Jiu-Jitsu [Ne-Waza]
- Fighting
- Duo – Male, Female, Mixed.
- Show – Male, Female, Mixed.
- **Contact** – **Only for Adults.**

5.2 Categories and Divisions

The following age divisions⁵ will be allowed to participate in this event.

6. Registration and Participation Fee

6.1 Registration

6.2 Participation Fees

US\$ 60 per individual athlete or DUO couple.

Late entry and late payment fees will be applied.

- Change (of an injured) competitor until registration deadline: free
- Change (of an injured) competitor after registration deadline (in the same category): **US\$ 10**.
- Change of the category of an athlete: **US\$ 20**.
- Late entry: **US\$ 50**.
- Additional entering of a competitor on site: **US\$ 80**.

6.3 Financial Conditions

The organization of the travel to the event and travel expenses are the responsibility of the participating countries.

Each federation must pay the cost of the accommodation and the participation to the local organizer.

Payment must be done by bank transfer until **20th September 2024** or take pre-approval that you will pay cash at the official registration and accreditation.

No accommodation or registration refund for participants not attending the Championship will be made.

7. Anti-Doping Control

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be doping control for several athletes. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations⁸.

If you are participating in the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2024 Prohibited List (<https://www.wada-ama.org/en/content/what-is-prohibited>)

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJIF automatically recognises all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so don't hesitate to get in touch with your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, don't hesitate to get in touch with the JJIF.

8. Competition Dressing and Personal Requirements & Advertising

Back Numbers/ Patches will be provided to the national federation to be sewed on the official Gi. Please ensure to have the correct Gi.

Please note that during the Championship, no Numbers/ Patches on the back of the Gi are allowed unless specified by the organizer. Numbers/ Patches on the back of previous tournaments must be removed from the Gi. Please observe the regulations of the JJIF as far as advertising on the Gi is concerned.

9. Referees

The participating countries are encouraged to bring referees to participate in the referee course and help to run the event and develop a regional referee team.

JJAU will send as a support, licensed referees working in this event, which means hotel with breakfast and dinner and transportation inside the country will be handled and covered by the OC.

International Instructors and supervising referees will be present.

The head referees appointed by TC will conduct a referee seminar with the possibility to renew and get international referee license.

Application: Referees can register via SportsID for the event and the Seminar All referees will be waitlisted first.

10. Coaches and Medical team from JJNO's

10.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coaches).

All Coaches must attend the briefing meeting on **04th October 2024**.

10.2 Medical Team

JJNO's may have its medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel, the medical team attendance at the medical meeting is mandatory.

10.3 Dress Code

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses⁹, shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed.

Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not allowed without press accreditation.

Every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person, wearing the team track suit.

11. Flags and Anthems

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible for each national federation, must check the flag and the national anthem during the accreditation process.

12. Visa

The Organizer must to help, as much as they can, to any country obtain a visa for athletes and officials. For Nations that need a VISA to enter in the country, please send the Organizer as soon as possible **(latest 31st August July 2024)** a list of participants with full names, passport numbers, date of birth and positions. (Add Picture [document format] and a picture of the passport, please).

Deadline for VISA support **(10th September 2024)** - after this date, you must take care of the VISA yourself, or additional costs will apply.
