IMPORTANT NOTES

The doors will open at 8.30am and the event will start 9.30am prompt. Coaches meeting at 9.15am, referees, judges and table officials meeting at 9.20am.

Photography and video recording: The SKA have engaged a photographer who will take some action shots of the competitors throughout the event. Video and photographs will be taken at the event for promotional purposes, however, should anyone have a concern please contact the event organiser prior to the event.

Important notes for coaches: Only official coaching band holders are permitted in the Tatami area (please register via Sportdata) Coaches must display their bands upon entry and throughout the day. Coaches must be in Association tracksuits and clearly display their coaching ID wristbands. Inappropriate dress, as deemed by the Chief Referee, will be refused access to the competition area. Only coaches adhering to the correct dress code and in possession of a coaching band will be allowed on the competition area when their competitors are competing.

First Aid: There will be a fully qualified medical team attending the tournament.

EKF Licence and Insurance: Please note that this competition is open to members of the English Karate Federation or members of other affiliated national governing bodies and competitors not in contravention of WKF Statute 21.9 only. Licence spot checks will be carried out on the day at registration/during bouts and competitors are reminded that a valid licence <u>MUST</u> be presented upon request of the organisers or their representatives, failure to do so may result in entry being denied. Licence books must contain a full and accurate grading history. By entering the tournament, you confirm that you fulfil this requirement.

It is the responsibility of everyone, (including the parent/guardian of a competitor, if under 18 years of age), to have their own insurance cover for the event. Club Instructors <u>MUST</u> please advise your competitors accordingly regarding insurance cover. It is the responsibility of the clubs/coaches to ensure that all competitors are aware of this and have been advised of adequate cover. Association/club parental consent to compete is also required. This is the responsibility of the Association.

Entry capping: Entries will be capped at 450 competitors and once this number has been reached entries will be closed.

The closing date for entries and payment of entry fees is Saturday 9th April or when the maximum number of competitors is reached if earlier. <u>No late entries will be accepted and no entries on the day or substitutions.</u>

Entry is via Sportdata. All entries must be made via Sportdata. Please email kentkarate@gmail.com for assistance with this if required. Payment <u>MUST</u> please be made at the time of submitting entry via Sportdata, entries will be placed on a waiting list until payment has been made, entries will then go live on Sportdata. Please ensure that if paying by BACS you give an identifying reference against your payment i.e., club/association name. Please also provide a receipt or confirmation of your BACS payment to the organiser via email kentkarate@gmail.com or text 07801639052. No refunds of entry fees in any event will be made.

Finals and Medal presentation: Each category will run straight through to the final and medals will be announced and awarded on the Tatami immediately after each category. Medals awarded for 1st, 2^{nd,} and joint 3rd places – no repechage in any events.

Spectators: Spectators £10, payable on the day (Cash Only please). Under 5yrs free.

General Rules of the Southern England Karate Open:

- WKF Rules will be used throughout the competition with slight modifications on certain age categories as appears below or in any subsequent Bulletins.
- Red and Blue flags system will be used for all events.
- Red and Blue belts are compulsory for all events.
- Competitors must wear a clean white traditional karate gi (Premier League Gi allowed)
- Competitor's age is as at the day of the competition.
- In any category if less than 3 athletes the organiser can merge/cancel the category.

Competitors please note: You may only compete in your own age and grade category and cannot move up to compete in another age/grade category – Exception the **OPEN** category for your age group. In the unlikely event of low entries in any category, the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate categories.

Kata Rules:

- Two competitors will compete against each other at the same time and event will be on a knockout basis.
- All junior grades Novice-4th Kyu, must perform one junior kata which may be repeated in every round (please see Kata list)
- All senior grades 3rd-1st Kyu must perform two kata, which must alternate in every round, can repeat in final. (WKF Kata List)
- All Open grade events will require a different Kata each round.
- AKA and AO will perform their Kata simultaneously i.e., on an area at the same time, except (time permitting) in Finals where they will perform independently.
- No repechage in any events.
- Para Kata may choose any Kata from the list, may repeat in wheelchair and intellectually impaired, visually impaired Kata must change Kata each round.

Kick Master Rules: Two competitors will compete against each other at the same time, on their own individual punch/kick bag.

- Each bout will last for 30 seconds.
- Hand Mitts are compulsory, shin and insteps advisable.
- Any punching, striking, or kicking techniques may be used.
- Red and Blue flag system will operate to determine winner.

Kumite Rules: WKF style red and blue mitts, belts and gum shields are COMPULSORY in all categories WKF style shin and insteps are COMPULSORY in all events 10 years and over and advisable for under 10 years. WKF style body protectors are COMPULSORY for 14 years and above and advisable for under that age. Females aged 14 years and above COMPULSORY chest protection.

- No repechage in any category. Losing semi-finalist both receive bronze medals.
- Under 12yrs 6 points clear, 12yrs and over 8 points clear wins.

- No head contact with hand techniques permitted for those under 16 enforcing the 10cm rule. Juniors 16-17 and adults, light "skin touch", will be scored.
- No head contact with foot techniques permitted for those under 14 and for 14 and above only light "skin touch" will be scored.
- Team Kumite: All members of team must be from the same club/association. If a team uses a member from another association this will result in Shikkaku.
- 3 competitor team events, teams can compete with 2 karateka. The winner is the team with most wins. If wins are the same, then most points scored. If points scored is the same, then it will be taken to a final match between nominated fighters. In the case of a draw in deciding bout, the referee panel shall decide on Hantei.
- Weight spot checks will be made throughout the day to ensure compliance. If a wrong weight has been submitted no transfer of category is possible and no refunds will be made.

Kumite bout times:

- 10 years and under I minute
- 11-13 years 1.5 minutes
- 14 years & over 2 minutes.
- Team matches all 1.5 minutes.

Please Note - we reserve the right to reduce bout times if we feel that this needs to be done in circumstances such as any unforeseen delays impacting on the finishing time of competition. If this does happen, we will let you know.

Officials: There will be a panel of Association, National or Internationally qualified judges and referees - Referees and Judges meeting at 9.20am.

Housekeeping: Bags and equipment MUST not be left where they potentially present a trip hazard. Spectators in the seating area should remain seated. Spectators should not stand by the barriers adjacent to the Tatami as this blocks the view of seated spectators and causes a potential health and safety hazard. Bags can be stored away in lockers provided or left at the back of the holding area at the athletes own risk.

Athlete Operating Procedure: Each category is scheduled to run on a specific Tatami. The category will be clearly announced over the public address system and the athletes in that category should then make their way to the warm-up hall where they will register. Coaches should ensure that their competitors have assembled in the warm-up hall and are wearing the correct equipment. A Tatami volunteer will then collect the competitors, and escort them to the tatami. Once at the tatami athletes will wait seated in aka/ao awaiting their bout. Coaches should consult the available draw sheets to determine the competitor position in the draw. (This will be displayed).

Compliance with the above procedure will help to maintain a constant flow and avoid competitors missing their bouts. Your support in this procedure is appreciated.

Important Rules for Parents & Spectators

Coaches, please communicate these important rules to parents, competitors, and supporters from your association:

- 1. Your/your club's entry to this competition is on the understanding that ALL parents and students accept the following rules.
- 2. Parents and spectators <u>CANNOT</u> approach any officials, tables, or referees under any circumstances.
- 3. The competition area is reserved for competitors and their coaches. Only competitors whose categories have been called will be able to enter the competition area. Parents/spectators will not be allowed in the competition area.
- 4. <u>No Protests</u> will be allowed concerning referees decisions by anyone. This competition is run in good faith, and we will all be doing our best to make it a successful day.
- 5. We would like everyone to enjoy the day and be able to support their club's competitors. We therefore ask for mutual respect in the spectators seating area please do not stand up when supporting competitors.
- 6. Photography & video parents and coaches are requested to turn off their flash options on their devices when taking photographs and videos of competitors.
- 7. Any infringements may result in the competitor or team being barred from the event and future events.
- 8. Entry to this event is on the understanding that the organisers and owner of the venue accepts no responsibility or liability for any injury or loss that may result from the event.
- 9. If the event is cancelled the organiser's responsibility will be limited solely to the return of any entry fees paid.
