TOURNAMENT RULES AND SCHEDULE

Throughout the Commonwealth Karate Championships, the World Karate Federation (WKF) rules will be applied and as such **only WKF approved protective equipment (inclusive of chest, leg, feet and hand protection) will be permitted. It is compulsory for all athletes competing in WKF categories in the Commonwealth Elite Championship and the Commonwealth Club Championship to wear WKF approved attire.**

The WKF and Karate Scotland comply with the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) code of practice and adopt a strict stance on anti-doping. Therefore, WADA rules will be applied throughout the championships.

The CKF Championship will comprise of two events, namely the Commonwealth Karate Championship (Elite) which will only be open to National Team athletes, and the Commonwealth Karate Club Championship will be open to all Commonwealth karateka that are members of the WKF. All athletes entering the elite championship are also allowed to enter the club championship.

At the Commonwealth Karate Championship (Elite) there will only be two athletes allowed in each category per National Team. However, in the Commonwealth Club Championship (which will take place after the Elite event is concluded) there will be no limit on the number of entries per category.

The two-day Commonwealth Karate Championship (Elite) event will take place on Thursday 5th and Friday 6th November. The Commonwealth Club Championship will follow and take place on Saturday 7th November and Sunday 8th November.

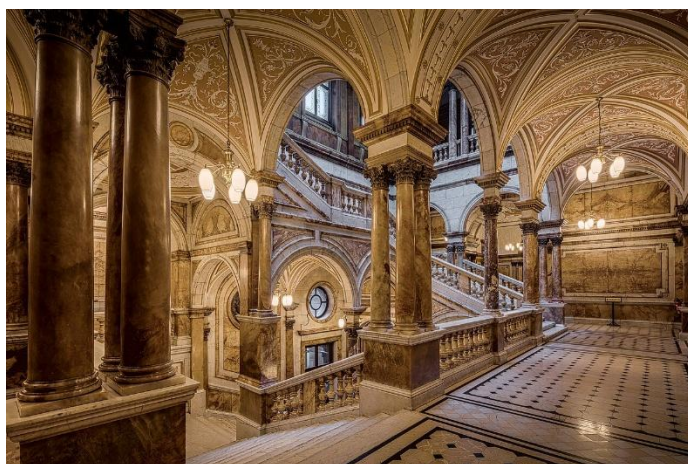
