12.1 Travel

By Plane

Sofia International Airport offers direct low cost and flag carrier flights to nearly all major cities and hubs in Europe and several in the Middle East.

By Train & Bus

Long distance and Night Trains connect Sofia with all major cities in the Balkan Area.

Sofia has regular Bus connections to every part of Europe.

European Emergency Number: 112

Calls can be answered not only in Bulgarian, but also in English, French, German, Italian, Spanish, Greek, Romanian, Turkish or Russian. Caller location is automatically activated when the call is answered.

The official language is Bulgarian. Most of the people also speak English.

The official currency in Bulgaria is the LEV.

The currency can be exchanges in all bank offices and currency exchange offices, located throughout the city of Sofia, mostly in shopping malls. The lev is pegged to the euro at a rate of 1.95583 LEV for 1 EURO. The most current information can be found on the National Bank website: www.bnb.bg

The time zone in the country is Eastern European Time (UTC+2)

Bulgaria's standard electricity supply is 220/230 volts AC with a frequency of 50 hertz.

Tap water is generally considered safe to drink in all major towns and cities.
