Until we meet soon, I warmly greet you and hope we will share some delightful moments at the 26th Međimurje Open!



#### **PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT**

Karate mitts, shin pads and foot protectors, body protectors and gum shields are mandatory for all competitors in kumite (including body protectors for Boys/Girls categories). For female Cadet/Junior/U21/Senior competitors is also mandatory to wear female chest protector. Groin guards and face masks are optional. Protective Equipment need to be of WKF type, but does not need to be WKF approved.

#### **GENERAL RULES**

All the necessery information concerning each competitor is obtained from passport or official document. All competitors must have a medical examination no older than 6 months, and the clubs and coaches who register competitors are responsible for complying with this rule. All competitors enter this competition at their own risk. Organizer is absolved of any claims, wich may arise however so caused (possible injuries, diseases, infections or any other form of threat to health and material damage). In case there is less than 4 competitors in one category, Organizer has right to join categories. With registration to tournament clubs authorize Organizer of the event to use images, photos, videos and the names of their competitors and other members of club delegations for the sport activities and publications of karate, related to the event, without monetary compensation. By registering for the competition, clubs and competitors accept all rules, terms and conditions of the competition.

#### LANGUAGE

In the Republic of Croatia the official language is Croatian. Many people though, especially the young, speak English.



#### EXCHANGE RATE AND OFFICES

 $1 \in = 7,50$  kn. Croatian currency is kuna. A kuna is worth 100 lipas. Foreign currencies can be exchanged in banks, exchange offices and post offices.



#### **BANKS OPENING HOURS**

Most of the banks and exchange offices in Croatia are open from 08-20 (Monday through Friday) and from 8 -12 on Saturdays, and most of the banks have ATMs in function 24h a day. Bank offices in the airports are open every day, including Sundays and holidays (7-21).



#### **CREDIT CARDS**

All principal credit cards (American Express, Diners Club, Eurocard/Master Card and VISA are indicated in commercial spots and accepted throughout Croatia.

#### ELECTRICITY

In Croatia the voltage is 220 V, 50 Hz, as in most European countries.





#### POST OFFICES



Post boxes (mail boxes) have a distinctive yellow colour. The main post office in Čakovec is situated near the main town square, on address Tome Masaryka 28. and it is open from 8-19 (Monday through Friday) and 8-13 on Saturdays. It is closed on Sundays.



#### **PUBLIC PHONES**

Public phone boots accept only phone cards available in post offices, gas stations, news-stands and shops. When calling from abroad, dial 00385 for Croatia, then 40 for Čakovec followed by the phone number needed.



#### HOSPITAL

To enter Croatia it is not compulsory to receive vaccination and possess a sanitary card. Health insurance is optional. Pharmacy shops are open from 7-20. In the event of accident or illness, call the Ambulance from any phone dialling 194 or 112 for free. #### WELCOME TO ČAKOVEC



Čakovec is a city in northern Croatia and county seat of Međimurje, which is located between the rivers of Mura and Drava. Čakovec is administrative, economic and cultular cener of the county.

The city itself has 17 000 inhabitants, and a total of 27 000 together with people live in the surrounding locations (Ivanovec, Krištanovec, Kuršanec, Mačkovec, Mihovljan, Novo Selo na Dravi, Novo Selo Rok, Savska Ves, Slemenice, Šandorovec, Štefanec, Totovec, Žiškovec) which also belong to city's administration. Rich history of Čakovec and Međimurje is kept in the Museum located in the Old Town Zrinski.

From modest medieval oppidum that appeared next to the fortress, Čakovec has. following the dinamic era of industrialization in the mid 19th century, grown to be modern european city.

Top communication, modern infrastructure, beautiful horticulture, dinamic cultural and sport content - all those are reasons for pleasurable life of its inhabitants. Beside the historic core of the city, tourists are offered great gastronomy, sports and freetime activities, immense night life and inviting events throughout the whole year. All that had been recognised on national level so Čakovec was acknowledged as best city of continental Croatia.















#### **MEÐIMURJE**

Međimurje is situated on the crossroads of two major relief units; Eastern Alps and the Pannonian Plain, on the basis of which defines two morphological units; hills above (with the highest peak Mohokos 345 meters above sea level) and plain lower Međimurje (part of the Pannonian Plain). Located in the northwest Croatian, traffic most connected part with Europe, is bounded by natural boundaries - the river Mura in the north and east and the river Drava in the south. Međimurje borders with Slovenia and Hungary, and is very close and Austria.

On the total surface of 730 km<sup>2</sup>, in most densly populated county in Republic of Croatia, live 105 000 inhabitants divided in 3 cities (Čakovec, Prelog and Mursko Središće) and 22 counties.

City Čakovec is administrative, cultural and political center of Medimurje county.
