• Formation of the prestige of sports and, as a result, formation of the prestige of a healthy lifestyle



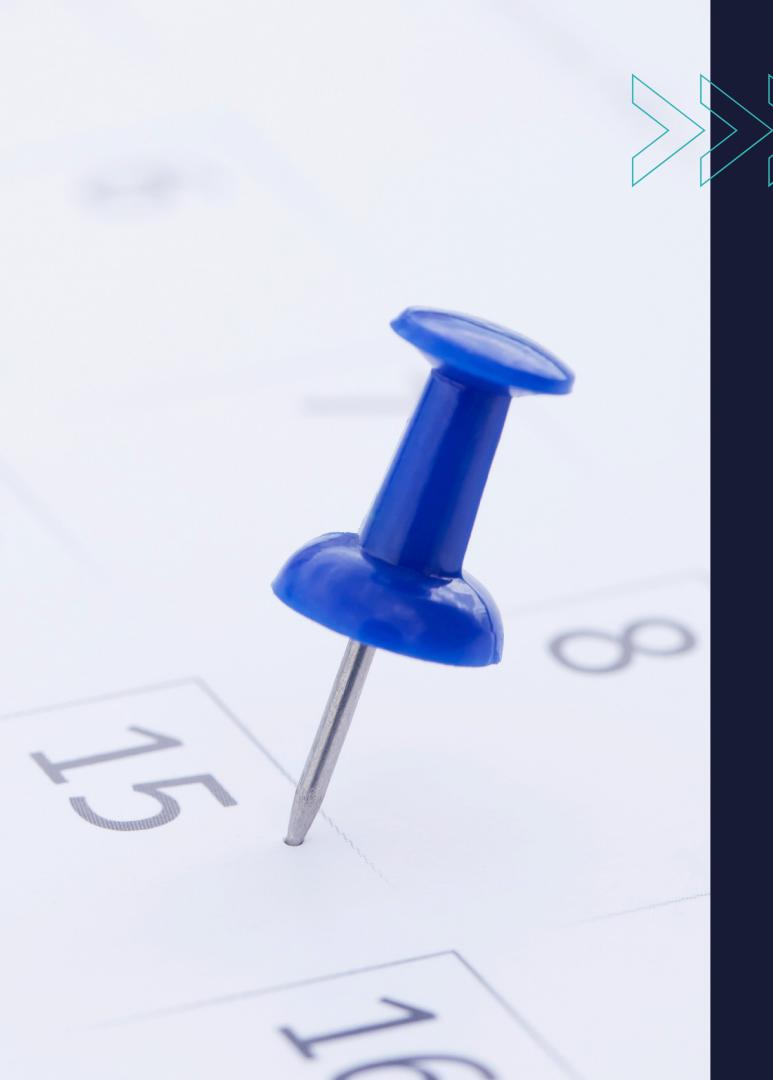


MANAGEMENT OF CHAMPIONSHIP

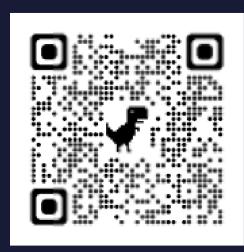

- •Total 32 kg (Pull/Chin-ups) + 48 kg (Dips) (open - professionals)
- Muscle Up with 10kg

Women's divisions:

• Total 12 kg (Pull/Chin-ups) + 16 kg (Dips)

AGE RESTRICTION

Athletes who are under the age of 18 at the time of the competition may take part in them only with the written consent of the parents or the legal representative of the child, in the prescribed form:

https://streetlifting.world/documents/. Athletes of this age group are allowed to participate in competitions only with a coach or parents or their legal representatives.

EQUIPMENT

Equipment and uniforms of athletes must comply with the ISF Rules.

Athletes who do not perform with the requirements on equipment and uniforms are not allowed to the platform.

INSURANCE

Every athlete has to consult with his doctor before taking part in competitions. All athletes perform at their own risk, realizing that they could be seriously injured.

Organizers are not responsible for health of the athletes, as well as risks associated with the trauma.





TRAVEL AND ACCOMONDATION OF PARTICIPANTS

All expenses for business trips and accommodation of members of national teams from those countries that are included in paragraph 5.5. are covered by the Organizers of the competition. Representatives of national teams of paragraph 5.6, bear all the costs of travel and accommodation independently.



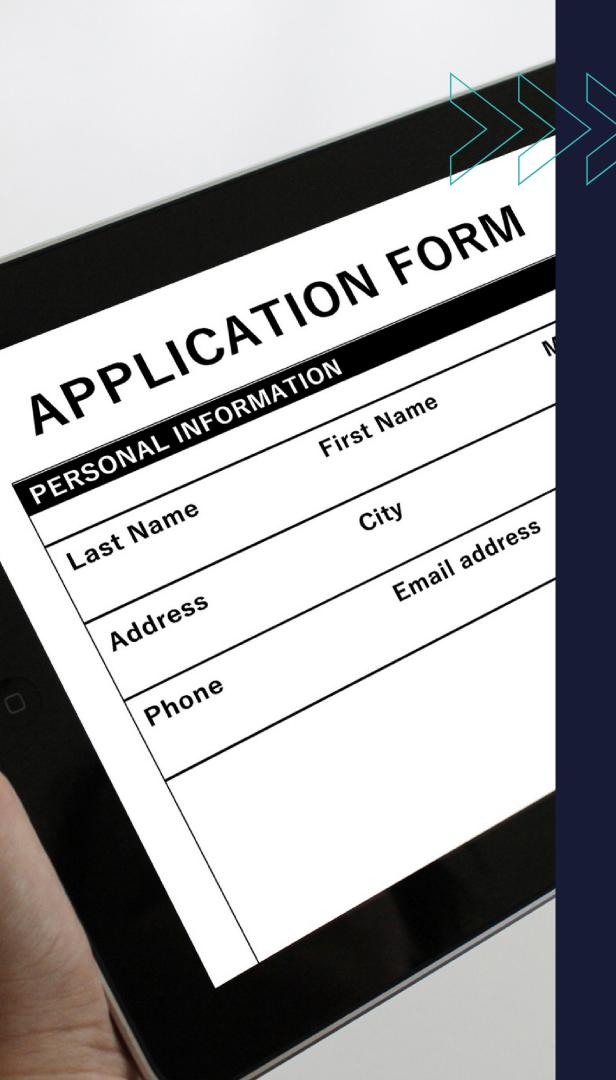

TEAM ORGANIZATION AND APPLICATION RULE

It is impossible to change something after November 19, 2022.

Regardless of whether an athlete performs in the individual competition or for the team, for each separately, athletes must be submitted an online application.





NATIONAL TEAMS

- Each national team should consist of 3 athletes: 2 men and 1 woman.
- Only 1 national team is allowed from each country.
- 2 national teams are allowed to participate the host country of the Championship.
- Each team must indicate an official representative of the team the Team Captain.

POINTS

- The team points are calculated and the winner is determined according to the ISF Technical Rules.
- Team points are awarded as follows: 12, 9, 8, 7, 6, for the first five places in any weight category. Every next athlete who has finished the competition and who has collected the total amount receives 1 point.

At the end of the competition, the captains of the teams must submit the file with the best nominations to the Head Secretary of the competition. The score of team points must be downloaded on the official website: https://streetlifting.world/forteams/.

PERSONAL REWARDING

Athletes, who take the first three places in each discipline get exclusive medals and diplomas.

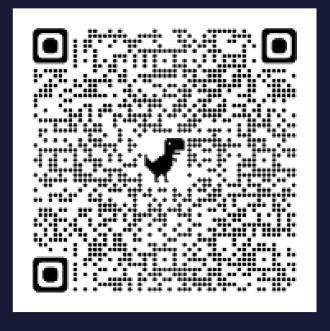
All awardees or their representatives have to be at awarding ceremony. In other way giving the prizes is not guaranteed.

THE CONTRACT FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION

Passing weighing procedure and registration, each athlete is required to sign the reverse side of the registration card. The fact of signing this card is the conclusion of an Agreement on the participation in the competition between the athlete and the organizers.

By signing the card, the athlete agrees with the clauses of this competition rule, as well as with all the points of technical regulations ISF/EUSF Federations and all of its decisions taken before the start of the competition and published on the official website.

Also, the athlete expressly agrees to the following conditions:

- Taking part in the competition, the athlete recognizes that it will require a maximum of physical and psychological stress, which entails a risk of injury or mutilation. The athlete assumes all risks associated with it and bears full responsibility for any injury and mutilation, about which he knows or not, that he can get.
- The athlete is realizing that he is responsible for the control of his health before taking part in the competition, thus confirming conducting regular medical check-ups, and the absence of medical contraindications for participation in competitions, respectively, his full physical fitness and voluntarily insured his life and health on the period of participation in the competition.



- Taking part in the competition, the athlete knowingly waives any claims in the event of injury or mutilation in this tournament, against ISF/EUSF Federations and ISF National Federations, the tournament organizers, the owner of the premises, directors, officers, employees, and assistants on the platform and all operating personnel of competition.
- Athlete voluntarily pays for all charitable contributions intended to repay the costs of the tournament, the production of awards merchandise and other expenses related to the sporting events.
- To conduct commercial photo or video filming, it is necessary to obtain accreditation from the organizing committee of the competition. All materials filmed and not accredited by photographers and video operators are considered freely distributed and the federation reserves the right to use them for its purposes without the consent of the author of these materials appearing open sources.

1RM - Each athlete has 3 attempts

The winners (1st, 2nd, 3rd place) are determined using the ISFpoints formula

All possible nominations of participants:

- 1) Classic Streetlifting (2 lifts) among Men of the Open category
- 2) Classic Streetlifting (2 lifts) among Women of the Open category
- 3) Classic Muscle Up among Men of the Open category

COMPETITIVE DISCIPLINES:

For Men:

- 1) Multilift Amateur 24/32 (2 lifts. Pull/Chin-ups with 24 kg + Dips with 32 kg)
- 2) Multilift Pro 32/48 (2 lifts. Pull/Chin-ups with 32 kg + Dips with 48 kg)
- 3) Muscle Ups with 10 kg

For Women:

1) Multilift 12/16 (2 lifts. Pull/Chin-ups with 12 kg + Dips with 16 kg)

Max rep - Each athlete has 1 attempt

The winners (1st, 2nd, 3rd place) are determined by the number of repetitions performed in individual exercises, or by the sum of the final results of both exercises
