The organisers of the event (or any of their officials or members) will not be liable or responsible for any personal injury.

Coaches and team leaders are responsible for ensuring that all participants are physically fit, prepared, and capable of coping with the tournament. We strongly recommend proper medical and accident insurance. Competitors compete at their own risk.

4 RULES AND DRAW

The following rules apply:

- JJIF competition rules (in their latest versions) and the Organization and Sporting code of JJIF Version 1.1¹ (SC).
- We appeal to all participants to respect the fair-play and JJIF book of ethics
- Athletes which subscribe for both events (U21 and Adults or Adults and Masters) must be aware that they have to do for each age category a separate weigh inn test.

4.1 Draw modus

The seeding and draw and block will be made on **Wednesday October the 1st 2025 at 19:00hr** and will be placed online on Sportdata.

Major changes² must be requested according to the following³:

- At official international championships, **no redraw** is possible, except for unforeseen cases when the JJEU Sports director may decide on a redraw.
- A redraw can be requested max. 2 hours after the draw was published but, in any case, before the start of the competition, **in writing**, to the JJEU Sports Director AND JJEU Secretary. (sport.director@jjeu.eu and rick.frowyn@jjeu.eu)

Seeding regulations of the JJIF will be observed. For the seeding in U21 and Adults, JJEU will use the world ranking list and registration to the event from **Friday September 18th 2025**. The JJNOs are responsible for making sure all points are correct in the raking list until this day.

4.2 Appeal and Challenge

Will be applied as defined in JJIF Sporting Code section Challenge and Appeal.

- * Change of the category of an athlete: 10 euro.
- * Late entry: 10 euro
- * Registration of a press person: 50 euro

- * Additional entering of a competitor on site: 50 euro

6.3 Participation Fee MASTERS

100 euro per participant/duo/show subscription

Late entry and late payment fees will be applied.

- * Change (of an injured) competitor until registration deadline: free
- * Change (of an injured) competitor after registration deadline (in the same category): 10 euro
- * Change of the category of an athlete: 10 euro.
- * Late entry: 10 euro
- * Registration of a press person: 50 euro
- * Registration of official: 10 euro
- * Additional entering of a competitor on site: 50 euro

6.4 Participation Fee EUROPEAN TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP for JiuJitsu or Fighting national teams

200 euro per TEAM (Max 2 TEAMS per Federation allowed)

TEAMS must be added in sportdata Adults event and confirmed not later than October 4th before 17:00 Local time by email to rick.frowyn@jjeu.eu

FIGHTING and JIUJITSU can contain 2 athletes subscribed max per weight category.

The next weight categories will be applied:

- Male -69, -85 and +85
- Female -52, -63 and +63

A team can maximum consist of 10 athletes from U21, Adults and Masters (2 per category).

Para JIUJITSU registration :

In these categories, Men, Women and Non-Binary Gender can compete against each other.

Don't miss your chance and register the events. After closure date we will create the pools in sportdata. In your email must be clear for which impairment the athlete(s) have, Age, weight, gender (Men, Women or Non-Binary) and category (Cognitive, Physical or Visual) For JiuJitsu the PARA JiuJitsu stakeholders and JJEU will create the pools. Registration via Sportdata ADULTS event.

7 ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be doping control for several athletes. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations⁴.

If you are participating in the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2025 Prohibited List

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJEU automatically recognises all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so please contact your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, please contact the JJIF.

8 COMPETITION DRESSING AND PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS & ADVERTISING

The national federations purchase the back numbers for all JJEU events, at the following link, from Ju-Sports, premium sponsor of the JJEU:

The JJNOs are then responsible for giving the back numbers to the athletes so that they can apply them to their Gi's prior to the competition. The national federations must pay the back numbers for their athletes by themselves. Participating without an official back number is not allowed. Please observe the regulations of the JJIF as far as advertising on the Gi is concerned⁵.

9 REFEREES

Application: For this upcoming European Championship, JJEU and BJF will be able to provide some compensation to the selected referees in terms of travel, accommodation and a day fee of € 100,00 per working day.

⁵ SC §4.1 Competition Dressing and Personal Requirements

The JJEU Head Referees, and JJEU Board are entrusted with the task to select the qualified referees for the event for each discipline at this event.

Referees should attend the briefing meeting on Wednesday afternoon. Referee MUST attend the whole competition at the event, early leaving is NOT possible.

Neither the organizing committee nor the JJEU will be responsible for not respecting this obligation. However, if there won't be enough referees for the competition to take place in good conditions, JJEU Referee Committee may decide to complement the pool of referees with national referees of the organizing federation. For the referees there is an own Sportdata page created, referees must insert themselves and should not be done by the federations.

JJEU entrusted committee will decide about participation in consideration of Discipline [s], Availability, License level, Evaluation and Ranking, Gender equality aspects, country. Continental and age mix

10 COACHES & MEDICAL PERSONNEL FROM JJNOS

10.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other official will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coach).

10.2 Medical personnel

JJNOS may have their medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel the attendance at the medical meeting is mandatory.

10.3 Dress code

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses, shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed. During finals business formal dress code is applied.

According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person⁶.

11 FLAGS AND ANTHEMS

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible of each national federation, must check the flag and the national anthem during the accreditation process.

12 FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

The organisation of the travel to Belgium and Travel expenses and hotel bookings are the responsibility of the participating countries. Each federation must pay the cost of the accommodation and the participation fees to local the organiser by bank according the next information:
