# Sharm Elsheikh

Sharm El Sheikh is an Egyptian city on the southern tip of the Sinai Peninsula, in South Sinai Governorate, on the coastal strip along the Red Sea. Sharm El Sheikh is the administrative hub of Egypt's South Sinai Governorate, which includes the smaller coastal towns of Dahab and Nuweiba as well as the mountainous interior, St. Catherine and Mount Sinai. The city and holiday resort is a significant centre for tourism in Egypt, while also attracting many international conferences and diplomatic meetings. Also it known as the "City of Peace" is referring to the large number of International Peace Conferences that have been held there.





# OFFICIAL COMPETITION VENUE AND ACCOMMODATION

# **Tolip Inn Sharm El-Sheikh**

Set in Sharm El Sheikh, 14 km from SOHO Square Sharm El Sheikh, Tolip Inn Sharm Spa and Aqua Park offers accommodation with a fitness centre, free private parking, a garden and a shared lounge. Among the facilities of this property are a restaurant, along with free WiFi. Certain units at the property feature a terrace with a city view.



### **Old Vic Resort**

Located in Sharm El Sheikh, 3.1 mi from Neema Bay, Old Vic Sharm Resort features a year-round outdoor pool and barbecue. The hotel has a terrace and spa center, and guests can enjoy a meal at the restaurant. Free WiFi is featured and free private parking is available on site.





### **Official Swimming Pool** The International Youth and Sports City

The International Youth and Sports City is a unique sports facility in Sharm El Shiekh and one of the largest sports complexes as well. The main object of the sports complex is an Olympic-size swimming pool where the race course is 50 meters in length. There are two swimming pools in the complex: one is 50X25m and the other is  $25 \times 12.5$ m. The pool is equipped with automatic timing system "ALGE-TIMING" and full-color video display. Pool is divided into 10 lanes. There is a video-audio control booth in the 'center of swimming' that can create and edit video and audio signal and transmit information. During sporting events the complex can accommodate up to 640 spectators.



### **Open Water** Sharm El Maya bay

Sharm El Maya Beach wraps itself some 1.5km around the inside of a pleasant cove in Southern Sinai. The beach is wide and sandy and runs from the ferry port in the South to the cliffs of Hadaba to the North.





### PARTICIPATION RELATED REGULATION

Only national federation teams affiliated to the CMAS are eligible to compete in the competition. Each national team should respect the rules of championships, the safety conditions set by the organizers and CMAS rules and regulations.

Swimming-pool & Open Water events:

- Each country may enter no more than two (2) swimmers for each distance and one (1) relay team.
- For relay races the names of the swimmers and their starting order must appear in a list submitted to the results office before the start of the session.
- The composition of mixed relays is with two (2) males and two (2) females and starting order is man woman man woman. Any change in the fixed starting order leads to disqualification.
- It is possible to change the composition of the relay teams between the qualifying heats and the final.
- The entries must reach CMAS headquarters within the time limits set by the CMAS rules according to the procedure attached (<u>www.cmasoffice.org</u> and Sportsid Sportdata).
  - Continental Championships will be organized over three (3) days and six (6) sessions.

#### **BOOKING & ENTRY FEES**

CMAS African Championship from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2023 to 6<sup>th</sup> November 2023 (5 nights) Entry fee per participant as follow:

- 400€ per participant in a Double / Triple room.
- 500€ per participant in a Single room.

The organizer will provide:

- Accommodation in three stars hotel with double or triple hotel rooms full board.
- Free transfers between the official hotel and competition place (training day include).
- Providing of 2x0,51 drinking water per Pax/per day
- Participation at the closing ceremony (gala dinner).
- Full board accommodation is considered as breakfast, warm lunch, and warm dinner.
- Participants who choose to be accommodated in hotels other than official will have to pay **200€/Person** for secretarial fees, competition, opening and closing gala ceremony. No local transfers will be provided.
- Transfers from international airport to hotel and return extra fees 20€/Person
- Extra night charged at 80€/Person/Day in a double/triple room and 100€/Person/Day in a single room, including full board accommodation.
- Training camp before championships please contact the organizers for pool availability and conditions.

ATTENTION! Late registrations cannot be accepted!

Minimum 50% of total entry fee should be deposited at our bank No later than October 10<sup>th</sup> 2023 to guarantee the booking. After this date the participation fees will increase by a Further 10% of total amount. The remaining payment should be made until arrival. Completion of payment will be checked at registration.

Payment should be made by bank transfer. (Bank cheque and credit card will not be accepted)
