Competition rules

Kata and kumite: Current WKF rules apply.

Competitors must be within their own age category on the day of the competition.

U12 = 10 and 11 years

U14 = 12 and 13 years

Cadets = 14 and 15 years

Juniors = 16 and 17 years

U21 = 18,19 and 20 years

Seniors = +18 years

Exceptions: For age categories U12 and U14 WKF Facemask and Chest Protector for children are **not** compulsory.

Protests

Current WKF rules apply. Protest fee is 200 euro.

- female: U12, U14, cadet, junior, U21 and senior
- male: U12, U14, cadet, junior, U21 and senior

Kumite

- female U12 -30kg -35kg -40kg +40kg
- female U14 -42kg -47kg -52kg +52kg
- female cadet: -47kg -54kg -61kg +61kg
- female junior: -48kg -53kg -59kg -66kg +66kg
- female U21: -50kg -55kg -61kg -68kg +68kg
- female senior: -50kg -55kg -61kg -68kg +68kg

- male U21:	-60kg -67kg -75kg -84kg +84kg
- male senior:	-60kg -67kg -75kg -84kg +84kg

The organizer reserves the right to combine and adjust categories depending on the number of athletes registered in the categories. Categories with maximum of four participants are round robin categories, if applicable. Two bronzes are awarded in kumite categories with more than four competitors.

Coaches

All coaches must register via sportdata.org by 3.11.2024

Number of coaches:

- 2 coaches maximum up to 10 entries
- 3 coaches maximum between 11 and 15 entries
- 4 coaches maximum for over 16 entries

Judges and referees

Chief referee is Lassi Saarenmaa.

Accommodation

Doping control

All competitors may be subject to doping testing.

Tickets

The voluntary admission fee for adults is 5€ and for persons under 15 it is 2€. **By contributing, you make these events possible also in the future!**

Insurance and licenses

All competitors must have a valid insurance policy that covers karate competition activities. Finnish competitors and coaches must have a valid national federation license with insurance coverage.

VISA

Finland is member of the Schengen states. The Schengen states have jointly agreed which countries' citizens are required to present a visa. Each Schengen state decides which passports and travel documents it accepts from different countries' citizens.

No visa is required when entering from a Schengen state. You must, however have legitimate passport or national ID-card, which may be required to show at the border.
