#### **Entries**

- All entries will be on a waiting list, until payment is received.
- Online entry closes for all categories on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> of September 2023, however in cases where a category reaches its maximum, online registration will close for this specific category BEFORE Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> of September.

#### Weigh In

- Weight category changes will only be possible on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October and the fee is €35.
- Those competing on Sunday (Under 14's) are not required to weigh in on Friday 13<sup>th</sup>, as random weight checks will be carried out on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup>.
- International Teams can apply to weigh in on Saturday morning by contacting the organiser in advance. Any competitor that misses weight on Saturday will NOT be allowed to fight.

- Red and blue belt
- red and blue fist protection
- red and blue foot / instep protection
- Gum shield
- Chest protector for female Cadet, Junior, U21, and Senior athletes
- Body protection for all athletes Aged 14 and over.

It is the responsibility of coaches to ensure that all competitors are registered and are in the correct categories. Competitors are only allowed to compete in their own age/weight category and are not allowed to move up a category.


All coaches must register on-line via Sportdata before the closing date and this is free of charge. After the online registration closes, Coach Passes will be issued for a fee of €100.

## Venue





#### **IMPORTANT NOTES**

### **Photography and Recording**

O.N.A.K.A.I. will engage an Official photographer and videographer who will take action/podium shots of the competitors. All images taken at the event will remain the property of ONAKAI and will be used for promotional purposes. By accepting this waiver, you are consenting to the use of such images.

All Photographers need to request an official accreditation from the organizer. They should not disturb the course of the tournament. The cost is €100.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES FOR COACHES**

**Coaches passes:** Only those in possession of a current valid NGB / National Federation Coach Accreditation will be issued with a Coaching pass.

#### **Protest**

Any protest concerning the application of the rules must be announced by the Coach no later than one minute after the end of the bout. The Coach will request the official protest form from the Tatami Manager and will have four minutes to have it completed, signed, and submitted to Tatami



Manager with the corresponding fee. The protest fee of €200 must be paid before the protest is handled to the Tatami Manager. The Tatami Manager will immediately hand the completed protest form to a representative of the Appeals Jury that will have five minutes to render a decision. Should the protest be approved, the fee will be refunded.

**Dress code:** Coaches must be in association tracksuits and clearly display their coaching ID badge. Inappropriate dress, as deemed by the chief referee, will be refused access to the competition area. Only coaches adhering to the correct dress code and in possession of a coaching pass will be allowed on the competition area.

**Competitors** can only compete in their own categories and cannot move up to compete in another category. In the unlikely event of low category entries, the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate categories.

**Insurance:** It is the responsibility of everyone, or parent / guardian of a competitor if under 18 years of age, to have their own insurance cover for the event. Please advise your competitors accordingly regarding insurance cover. It is the responsibility of the clubs/coaches to ensure that all competitors are aware of this and have been advised of adequate cover. Association/club parental consent to compete is also required. This is the responsibility of the association.
