
Competition system for the 10th WIKF Global Cup 2022

Except for the team competition, the Sir William Millerson Cup, Suzuki champions cup and all open categories, ALL the individual kumite categories will be fought under the Cup system as shown below. Each category will start with pools, such as pool A and pool B. There will be competitors in 2 pool and they fight round robin. The below example shows the following: after the round robin round is finished, No. 1 in Pool A will fight No 2 in pool B and No 2 in pool A will fight No 1 in pool B in the semifinals. The winners will go to the final and the losers will get the bronze medals as there is no repechage. With the below system every competitor can afford losing one fight but still make it to the final.
