# 3 Liability

Coaches and team leaders ensure that all participants are physically fit, prepared, and capable of coping with the tournament. We strongly recommend proper medical and accident insurance. Competitors compete at their own risk.

By participating in the event, competitors acknowledge the sport can be very dangerous and hereby release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the FCJJ, JJIF, UPJJ, City of Bogotá and any persons involved with said organizations and/or planning.

# 4 Rules and draw

The following rules apply:

- JJIF competition rules (in their latest versions), Organization and Sporting code of JJIF Version 3.1 (OSC).<sup>1</sup>
- We appeal to all participants to respect the fair-play and JJIF book of ethics.
- For age division U8 – U12, the rules FJCC rules will be used:
  - **Jiu-Jitsu**, only cross choke and hadaka jime and arm bar will be allowed, when the opponent is at risk, the match is stopped and the winner is given to the athlete applying the submission; kakae jime (Ezequiel) is not allowed. In a closed guard position, it is not allowed to stand up with the partner.
  - **Fighting system**: the submission of the athlete to the bar under the osaikomi arm will not be taken into account, it will be directly ippon if the arm is stretched; kakae jime (Ezequiel) is not allowed.

## 6 Registration and Participation Fee

### 6.1 Registration

It is **not possible** after the 12<sup>th</sup> of September to change or add competitor

### 6.1 Participation Fee

The registration fee is \$60 USD per participant. Participant may choose to do one additional discipline for an additional cost of \$20 USD.

### 6.2 Financial conditions

The organisation of the travel to the event and travel expenses are the responsibility of the participating countries. Each federation must pay the cost of the accommodation and the participation to local the organiser.

Payment must be done by bank transfer until **12th of September** or take pre-approval that you will pay cash at the official registration and accreditation. No accommodation or registration refund for participants not attending the Championship will be made.

## 8 Coaches & Medical personnel from JJNOs

### 8.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coaches). At least one Coach or Medic per JJNO must prove the participation in the coach seminar of WADA or a similar course. Medical personnel

### 8.2 Dress code

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses<sup>6</sup>; shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed.

Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not allowed without press accreditation.

According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person<sup>7</sup>.

## 9 Flags and Anthems

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible for each national federation, must check the flag and the national anthem during the accreditation process.

## 10 Visa

The Organizer is happy to help any country obtain a visa for athletes and officials. For nations that need a VISA to enter the country, please send the Organizer as soon as possible (latest **13<sup>th</sup> August**) a list of participants with full names, passport numbers, date of birth and positions.
