Dress code:

Coaches must be in association tracksuits and clearly display their coaching ID badge. Inappropriate dress, as deemed by the Chief Referee, will be refused access to the competition area. Only coaches adhering to the correct dress code and in possession of a coaching pass will be allowed on the competition area.

All competitors, coaches and supporters are responsible for their own personal safety and belongings. The organisers, officials and staff take no responsibility for the loss, damage or theft of personal items. Furthermore, participants must follow the instructions of the officials and Centre staff.

Contestants must wear a white karate gi without stripes,

Coach: Medical

We record every injury that gives us the slightest concern, however symptoms often occur after the incident and we would ask that the coach or representative informs the medical team of any concerns he or she has at the time of the incident, or any time after, no matter how trivial it may seem.

Insurance: It is the responsibility of each individual, or parent / guardian of a competitor if under 18 years of age, to have their own insurance cover for the event. Please advise your competitors accordingly regarding insurance cover. It is the responsibility of the clubs/coaches to ensure that all competitors are aware of this and have been advised of adequate cover. Association/club parental consent to compete is also required.

This is the responsibility of the association.

Health and Safety issues have been discussed and we try to plan for every eventuality. However, this is a busy tournament and due care and attention is required in all areas. Would all coaches/parents ensure that their children are properly chaperoned. Karate matches are performed in bare feet; please ensure proper footwear is used in the arena and surrounding areas, especially approaching the mats.

People can and do get injured and we cannot accept responsibility for any such injury, loss or accident arising from your participation in our training, competitions or associated activities and ask that you are aware, agree and accept this by entering or giving permission to enter this event. We should also be notified, in writing, of any medical condition that may have relevance to their participation in Karate.

World Karate Federation (WKF) rules shall apply throughout the entire competition.

Rules of the day

The event will start at 9.00am prompt

A minimum number of THREE (3) athletes are required to form a category. If fewer athletes Are available for a category, then they will be transferred to a higher category (first by weight And then by age). This process continues by alternatively attempting a higher category, first by Age then by weight, until the athlete can be fitted into a category.

Judges and Referees should arrive at 0900 for briefing and to assist in setup. Competitors in the first categories of the day should be ready to start at 9.30am prompt. For all other categories competitors should be in the arena a minimum of 1 hour prior to category scheduled start time. Should the event run ahead of schedule category start times may be brought forward. Competitor check-in will be carried out prior to each category starting.

Kata 7-9 years may alternate Katas (performing a minimum of 2 different Katas).

Kata 10-13 years may alternate Katas (performing a minimum of 3 different Katas).

Kata 7-11 years. AKA and AO will perform their Kata simultaneously i.e. on an area at the same time.

Kata and Kumite for 14 years and above will be held under WKF rules. WKF rules will be strictly applied in all categories for 15 years and above.

Kumite weigh in: We will operate weight checks. Any competitor found not to be the correct weight for the category they have entered will not be allowed to compete. We cannot move competitors to another weight category if they fail the weight checks. Teams: All members of team must be from the same club/association.

Individual and Team KUMITE Rules that will be applied during this competition will be in accordance with those published and as amended from time to time by the World Karate Federation.

A competitor can compete in both his/her weight category and an appropriate open category.

¬ Weighing in: Athletes that are found over or under the designated weight category will be disqualified.

This also applies for the age category that the athlete should fit in on the day of the championship.

Only a discrepancy of + or -500 grams will be allowed.

STRICTLY NO LATE ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

- In order to ensure the manageability of the tournament and to provide an appropriate level of Competition, the organizers reserve the right to remove and combine categories without notice.
 The final event categories will be communicated to team coaches following the closing of entries And competition sheets will be displayed on the walls of the Dojo at the start of the tournament
- 2) All Clubs/Organisations are asked to provide one or more referees/judges if possible, Who's Names Qualifications and contact details (phone and email address)must be entered on the entry Form. They will be given free refreshments throughout the day and a free lunch. Referees/judges must be Infull unform i.e. grey trousers, blue blazer, white short-sleeved shirt, red tie and black shoes.
- 3) All coaches will be issued with a coach badge. Only one coach will be allowed for every 10 competitors. This rule will be strictly applied Only the official coach (with a badge) may approach the control table for any queries. Competitors and spectators MUST go via their coach for information.
- 4) Coaches must wear their association track suits when entering the tatami area. The association coach will only be allowed in the tatami area when their competitor is fighting or performing kata. Only one coach is allowed per competitor for kumite. Any competitor, coach or representative who behaves discourteously to any member of the refereeing panel may cause the immediate disqualification of their competitor and could ultimately lead to disqualification of their whole team.
- 5) The named coach is responsible for the behavior of all his/her competitors and any spectator accompanying their competitors. He/she is responsible for obtaining parental or guardian permission for entry into the event and checking that their competitors have appropriate insurance, through their respective associations.
- 6) Coaches must be absolutely certain that their competitors are entered into the correct category. It may not be possible to change entries on the day.
 - 7) First Aid will be provided on the day by First Aid Cover Limited.
- 8) All jewelry must be removed or covered. Fingernails and toenails must be short.

 The wearing of metallic teeth braces must be approved by the Chief Referee and Official Medical Representative. If accepted, then the parent/guardian/coach must accept full responsibility should the user be injured.
- 9) All competitors must be fully insured by their association and must have their licenses on hand to be checked if required
- 10) There will be free parking the day on the premises.
