4.1 Draw modus

The seeding and draw-en-bock will be made on 21st August: 16:002

Immediately after the draw has been finalised, the categories will be made available online on the Sportdata Event Website. JJNOs have the right to request minor changes3 in the following 2 hours, in writing, to the organising committee.

Major changes⁴ must be requested according to the following⁵:

- At international events, no redraw is possible except for unforeseen cases when the OC may decide on a redraw.
- A redraw can be requested max. two hours after the draw was published, but, in any case, before the start of the competition, in writing, to the OC.

Seeding regulations of the JJIF will be observed. For the seeding, JJIF will use the world ranking list and registration for the event from 10^h August 2023. The JJNOs are responsible for making sure all points are correct in the ranking list until this day.

4.2 Appeal and Challenge

Will be applied as defined in JJIF SC2023 1.0, § 4.4 Challenge and Appeal.

Right to participate and categories

Based on the JJIF SC2023 1.0 § 2.3.2. Entries of Competitors:

Each JJNO may enter four (2) contestants in each category for the Youth World Championships.

- Late entry for competitor, coaches and officials: 25\$
- Additional entering of a competitor, coach or official on site: 75\$

6.3 Financial conditions

The organisation of the travel to the event and travel expenses are the responsibility of the participating countries. Each federation must pay the cost of the accommodation and the participation to the local organiser.

Payment must be done by bank transfer until 20th August 2023 or take pre-approval that you will pay cash at the official registration and accreditation. No accommodation or registration refund for participants not attending the Championship will be made.

The transfer/payment receipt has to be shown at registration. Please note that the JJNOs must fulfil all financial obligations before registration.

6.4 Pre-accreditation process

A pre-accreditation process will be put in place in order to reduce the passage time during the accreditation day.

This process is explained in the "accreditation process" document, which available for download on Sportdata.

Anti-doping Control

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be doping control for several athletes. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations⁸.

If you are participating in the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2023 Prohibited List (https://www.wada-ama.org/en/content/what-isprohibited)

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJIF automatically recognises all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so don't hesitate to get in touch with your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, don't hesitate to get in touch with the JJIF.

Competition Dressing and Personal Requirements & Advertising

Back Numbers⁹ will be sent to the national federation to be sewed on the official Gi. Please ensure to have the correct Gi.

Please note that during the Championship, no numbers on the back of the Gi are allowed unless specified by the organiser. Numbers on the back of previous tournaments must be removed from the Gi.

Please observe the regulations of the JJIF as far as advertising on the Gi is concerned 10.

9 Referees

The organising committee will take care of the referees working in this event, which means booking flights and hotels and transportation will be handled and covered by OC.

Application: Referees can register via SportsID for the event Deadline: 13th July 2023. All referees will be waitlisted first.

The Technical Commission (Head referee of Discipline) will decide about participation in consideration of Discipline [s], Availability, License level, Evaluation and Ranking, Gender equality aspects, country. Continental and age mix

There will be seminars for all disciplines before the event. Please register on Sportdata.

10 Coaches & Medical personnel from JJNOs

10.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coaches). All Coaches should attend the briefing meeting (digital). We will allow a maximum of 1 coach for each 5 athletes.

10.2 Medical personnel

JJNOS may have its medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel, attendance at the medical meeting¹¹ is mandatory.

10.3 Dress code

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses¹²; shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed.

Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not allowed without press accreditation. According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person.

Formal clothes (costume or suit) are mandatory for coaches for the final block. No jeans allowed.
