4 Right to participate and categories

Members of JJIF and/or CSIT can register their athletes directly in the event.

4.1 Registration via individual JJIF membership

Individual athletes that are not members of a JJNO or CSIT can register to become JJIF individual members of JJIF. JJIF will charge an additional fee of **30 EUR** for non-members

4.2 Categories

The age following age divisions¹ will be allowed to participate in this event.

Masters 2	Between 40 and 44 years old	1983 - 1979
Masters 3	Between 45 and 49 years old	1978 - 1974
Masters 4	Older than 50 years	1973 or older
U16 (+14-16)	14/15 years old	2008 / 2009
U14 (+12-14)	12/13 years old	2011 / 2010

Official JJIF Weight categories will be used²

In the **U14** and **U16** categories, only athletes that did **not** participate in the **World Championships 2022 and 2023** are permitted.

In the Masters categories, only athletes that did **not** participate in the World Championships 2022 and 2023 under Adults are permitted.

- All categories can be merged if there are not enough participants.
- JJIF will generate the draws and a live timetable on the sportdata event page.
- There will be no seeding.

5 Accreditation

The accreditation will be done on **September 6th**, from 14:00 – 18:00 at tbc.

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible for each national federation, must check the flag and the national anthem during the accreditation process.

6 Arrival and Departure & Transportation

The organization will provide meeting points at Bologna International Airport (BLQ) where all participants should meet on arrival. Information about transport to the housing will be given at the meeting points. LOC does not organize transfers from any other airport. LOC and JJIF agreed on the following arrival days:

- September 5th: Arrival Day for participants
- September 10th: Departure Day for participants
- 6.1 Transportation from and to the airport and train station Bologna

8 **Contribution & Accommodation**

8.1 JJIF contribution

JJIF must charge contributions to cover the organization's costs (Referees/ITOs).

This contribution will be **250 EUR** per person (athletes and extra officials)

Competing in a 2nd category will **130 EUR** per person (athletes and extra officials)

JJIF will create and send invoices based on the entries you make on sportsdata.

This includes the:

- Accreditation ID-card, which allows access to venues, the athletes' village, opening and closing ceremonies, etc., according to the access levels established for the cardholder by CSIT and LOC¹.
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (venues, athlete villages)

Delegates who are not accommodated within the Games transportation loop will be responsible for making their way to the athletes' village for meal service and participating in the Games transportation system.

Note that LOC and JJIF will not provide support or remedy issues for any accommodations secured through any non-partner providers.

8.2 Accreditation & Accommodation

Booking is not possible anymore. You need to organise your own accommodation.

9 Visa

Determine if you need a Visa to enter Italy.

Depending on your country of origin, you may require a visa to enter Italy. You can request a visa from the Italian Embassy or Consulate in your country of residence and it will generally be issued after 90 days.

To find out which countries require a visa to enter Italy, please visit <u>www.esteri.it</u>. On this website, you can enter your nationality, your country of residence, the duration of your stay (less than or more than 90 days) and the reason for your trip. Remember that once you arrive at the border, the authorities may request documentation justifying your reasons for and duration of your stay in Italy.

Please visit <u>https://www.italia.it/en</u> for more details. The local organizer (CSIT) can support you with Visa letters.

The information you need to fill in the Invitation Letter are the following:

- Organisation's legal name and official address
- Data of participants: First Name; Family Name; Number of Passport; Role in the delegation (manager, coach, official, athlete, companion, other);





• The competitions, sport or other activities your delegation will participate.

The AiCS Organiser Committee (EMILIOC) provides a dedicated staff in order to manage participants' specific requests dealing with Visa.

10 Competition Dressing & Sponsors and Promotion

Please note that we will strictly apply SC 4.1 Competition Dressing and 10.7 Sponsor Areas, Patches and Stitching³. If your gi does not fulfil the requirements, you might not be allowed to compete.

10.1 Back Patches

There will be NO Taylor at the event, so you need to add the back patches before the event. Pack Patches are not mandatory.

You can buy back patches for the event online. We are working on a special arrangement.

10.2 Personal sponsors

Please note that personal sponsors need to be validated and confirmed by LOC. If you plan to present personal sponsors on your gi, please specify which sponsor and how it will be displayed until **Juni 15th**, Please note that you might not be able to compete if you have -nonapproved sponsors on your gi!

11 Coaches, Media & Medical personnel from JJNOs

All coaches and medical personnel have to register to become "extra team officials" and access the venue and the field of play.

11.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching All Coaches should attend the briefing meeting.

At least one Coach or Medic per JJNO must prove participation in the coach play-true seminar of WADA or a similar course.

11.2 Medical personnel

JJNOs may have their medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel, attendance at the medical meeting⁴ is mandatory. They should be registered as officials for the event with the titles of Medics.

- Legal Practise for foreign medical and paramedical officers is limited and restricted according to the specific decisions of the state governor explicitly taken for the games. This means medical can only treat their own athletes.
- Request for treatments and analysis/test must come first from the participants through their official staff
- The LOC medical staff will work in close collaboration with them.

11.3 Dress code

dresses⁵, shorts, flip-flops, hats

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses⁵, shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed. Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not permitted without press accreditation.

According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person.

12 Covid 19 related measures

Please be aware that regulations about entering Italy might change on short notice, and neither JJIF nor LOC can guarantee them. At the moment, there are no travel restrictions to Italy.

JJIF cannot verify your vaccination status. Please check with your embassy if you are not sure. JJIF does not know or look up the requirements to re-enter your home country.

13 Anti-doping Control

All members should make their competitors aware that several athletes could be doping control. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations⁶.

If you are participating in the event and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2023 Prohibited List (<u>https://www.wada-ama.org/en/content/what-is-prohibited</u>)

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJIF automatically recognizes all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so please contact your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one. If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or no NADO in your country, please contact the JJIF.
