### 2 The official Hotels

The organiser must distribute to the official hotels to assure that National teams can stay together.

The number of requested rooms, availability and time of booking will determine which hotel can provide them.

## 3 Travelers under 18 years old

# 4 Before you fly - Passport / PCR / ICA

Be sure to have a passport with, al least, 6 months validity until the expire date.

Contact the airline for specific requirements for the flight.

Following government directives, you must register via the ICA Smart Travel Service before your flight. This applies to adults and children/infants and if you are travelling to Dubai or another emirate.

## 5 Arrival

In both Dubai and Abu Dhabi Airports the organization will provide meeting points, where all participants should meet on arrival. Information about transport to the hotels will be given in the meeting points.







### 6 Communication: Sim-card and Voice over IP calls

A local mobile number simplifies the management of test results, activation of Al Hosn App and will protect you from high Data roaming costs.

SIM packages are available from AED 50.00





Calls via Internet for many Apps do not work properly.

The App "BOTIM" is functioning well in UAE to stay in touch with your beloved ones.

### 7 Covid 19 related measures

Please be aware that regulations about entering UAE might change on short notice, and neither JJIF nor UAEJJF can guarantee

These measures will be more clarified in the hygiene protocol of the event, which will be published later.

- Participants (athletes, officials, ITOs, ...) don't need to quarantine (regardless if vaccinated or not)
- One Arrival PCR test is required organised by the local organising committee
- Missing or refusing mandatory tests will lead to exclusion from the event
- The local organising committee will cover by costs for these testing

# 8 Al Hosn App

Vaccination and testing is not a condition of entry to Abu Dhabi and the event but you will need it to move freely about the city.


All Hosn app is mandatory to enter in all public spaces in UAE. You can prove the vaccination with other documents as well but we advise all participants to download and activate the app.

For activation you need you UID (Unified Identification Number) number. It is on your Visa letter. If you get VISA on arrival, ask the immigration officer for this number.

In order to support entry for visitors, DCT Abu Dhabi has outlined a simple process to enable tourists to register their international vaccination certificate or vaccination exemption document for verification 5 days before their travel date, via the Federal Authority for Identity and Citizenship (ICA) Smart app or via <a href="https://ica.gov.ae/en">https://ica.gov.ae/en</a> website.

Applicants will receive an SMS confirmation that will include a link to the Al hosn app, which must be downloaded prior to travel. The Al hosn app displays users' vaccination status and PCR test results, which are required to activate the Abu Dhabi Green Pass.

Travellers who get the visa on arrival, will receive a *Unified ID number*, from airport immigration or via the ICA website. This is essential for setting up your profile on the Al hosn app. You'll need to link a phone number to the Al hosn account (the same one you've used for the ICA). This will complete the registration on the Al hosn app. Following a PCR test at the airport, visitors can activate the Green Pass.















## **Face Masks**

Use of the face masks in only mandatory in mosques, public transportation means like buses, medical facilities. the following categories have to remain masked:

- 1. Food service providers
- 2. Covid-positive cases
- 3. Those suspected of having Covid

### 12 Accreditation and Back Patches

As usual the accreditation will be done one day before the competition starts 28th Oct, in the arena

We organize a tailor to fix back patches.

Please do not delay to submit your Gi's when you arrive.

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible of each national federation, must check the flag and the national anthem during the accreditation process.

#### 12.1 Pré-Accreditation

All countries can confirm their registered names, flag and national anthem by email and make the payment before travel. Once it's done, they will receive all accreditation cards on hotel arrival.

The pre-accreditation process saves a lot of time from organization.

### 12.2 Payment / Reimbursement

The registration is only complete if all costs are paid according to the registration. In case of a missing athlete, to have the registration money returned, the national federation must fill a form, which will be reviewed by the organizing committee. There is no automatic entitlement for reimbursement.

Please respect that the employs and volunteers at registration have no authority to make any financial decisions.

# 13 Anti-doping Control

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be doping control for several athletes. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations<sup>1</sup>.

If you are participating in the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2022 Prohibited List

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJIF automatically recognises all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so please contact your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, please contact the JJIF.

## 14 Transportation

There will be buses going and back to Arena from the hotels in the morning and in the afternoon.

All delegations will have their transport back to the airport from hotel. You must inform the volunteers/ LOC in time to schedule the departure time.

Transportation is only provided for participants staying in official Hotels!

## 15 Coaches, Media & Medical personnel from JJNOs

#### 15.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coaches). All Coaches should attend the briefing meeting (digital) on October 24th).

At least one Coach or Medic per JJNO must prove the participation in the coach true seminar of WADA or a similar course.

#### 15.2 Media

On the Sportdata platform is separate registration for Media and Press. Please use this one to register Journalists or Photographers.

Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not allowed without press accreditation.

### 15.3 Medical personnel

JJNOS may have<sup>2</sup> its medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel the attendance at the medical meeting<sup>3</sup> is mandatory.

They should be registered as officials for the event with the titles of Medics

Abu Dhabi has restrictions and special license for all kind of medical personal and treatments. Treatment on the mat is restricted to Abu Dhabi licensed medical personal. Stay in touch with JJIF medical commission (<a href="medics@jjif.org">medics@jjif.org</a>) to clarify the possibilities of treatment in the event.

#### 15.4 Dress code

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses<sup>4</sup>, shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed.
