5. Immigration, VISA & Covid Protocol

All participants at the AKF Championships must hold a valid passport. The expiry date of the passport should be no shorter than at least 3 months of the departure day from Tashkent.

For visit Uzbekistan You can get e-visas through the e-visa portal (https://e-visa.gov.uz/main). After completing the application form, you will receive confirmation by email that your application has been received, and will be asked to pay the visa fee. The fee is US\$20 for a single-entry visa. Within 3 working days you will receive the electronic visa by email in PDF format.

In the unlikely event that the e-visa is not granted, you will be notified by email. In this case, you may wish to try applying for an Uzbekistan visa at an embassy or consulate instead. 6.4. Registration for Athletes, Coaches & Officials

6.4.1 General Rules for Registration

All competitors, officials, and officiating coaches must register online using the sportdata online system starting 00:01 (Dubai Time) on 1st October 2022, and will be ended at 23:59 (Dubai Time) 30th November 2022.

National Federations are responsible for the registration of their delegation. Online registration for delegation will be open on 1 October 2022, and will be closed on 30 November 2022 at 23:59 (Dubai Time). After the closing date, any late registration or amendments will be penalized with a penalty of \$20 USD per entry or per amendment.

Last minutes registration or amendment, during the onsite registration, will be subjected to a penalty of \$100 USD per entry or per amendment. There will be no more amendment nor new registration after the on site registration closed.

Accreditation cards will be issued during the official onsite registration upon confirmed received of full payment. The accreditation card must be worn at all times during the event.

The qualification for age groups shall be with reference to the first day of the Championship which is 16 December 2022.

6.4.2 Registration for Officiating Referees & Coaches

(i) All NF participating in AKF Championship shall be obligated to send qualified referees to officiate. The minimum qualification of the referees to be sent by the NF is of AKF Kumite RA / Kata JA. The number of referees to be send by NF for officiating in the Championship shall be according to the number of athletes from the NF participating in the Championship, as follows:

Number of Athletes from NF	Minimum Referees from NF
5-10 athletes	1 referee
More than 10 athletes	2 referees
Less than 5 athletes	No minimum

(ii) If the NF cannot comply with the minimum referee requirements then







the NF shall be liable to pay a levy of \$100 USD per referee short. This amount shall be payable to the Treasury of AKF during the official onsite registration.

- (iii) There shall be no limit to the number of Referees sent by NF for officiating in the Championship however at any one time there shall be no more than 8 referees officiating at the same time.
- (iv) The registration for coaches shall be as follows:

6.5. Official Onsite Registration

The onsite registration and accreditation will begin in the HQ hotel from 12th December 2022 till 14th December 2022.

- Each participating National Federation is required to submit 2 standard size flags, and a short version of their National Anthem in CD or USB Drive.
- Each Participating team must fill in and submit the liability forms as append to this bulletin (appendix 1 - 4).

6.6. Specific Information for Para Karate

6.6.1. Para Karate registration

Online registration can be made under the following <u>link</u>. All athletes registered shall be on the waiting list.

During the registration procedure upload all essential Para Karate athlete's medical documentation to the Sports ID Para Karate athlete's profile (these uploaded documents do not need to be sent by email to the HQ).

Only those athletes having their documents uploaded <u>until the end of registration</u> and having an eligible impairment may be moved from the "waiting list" to the







actual list of registered athletes for the event.

An athlete without eligible impairment for para-karate will not be moved from the waiting list.

The Head of para-karate classification can ask for supplemental medical documentation to prove the underlying health condition of the athlete. The mandatory forms can be found in the following links:

To be considered eligible to compete as an athlete with an intellectual disability, athletes must fulfill the full eligibility criteria as defined by VIRTUS.

 Committee. However, should you require any assistance, or there is no
 VIRTUS representative in your country, please contact the Para Karate

All documents MUST be attached in English for ALL registered athletes.

All MDFs must be completed by a registered Medical Doctor, M.D.

All athletes must attend the classification session on Friday, 16th December at the HQ Hotel, between 10:00 – 18:00.

6.6.2. PARA-KARATE ATHLETES PER CATEGORY

Every nation has the opportunity to register three (3) Para-Athletes per sport class. In total, 24 athletes can be called by each nation.

6.6.3. <u>CLASSIFICATION SESS</u>ION

Classification in Para-Karate consists in an extra point compensation depending on the influence of the particular impairment when performing the Kata. Detailed information can be found in the Para-Karate regulations: https://www.wkf.net/sport-parakarate.

Please, check the Para-karate Classification rules https://www.wkf.net/pdf/ParaKarate Classification Rules.pdf or Para-Karate information sheet https://www.wkf.net/pdf/Para Karate Info%20Sheet.pdf to ensure that the athlete presents at least one of the mentioned eligible impairments which have to be proven by the MDF.

Registered Para-Karate athletes must present themselves for a mandatory onsite Classification Session performed by qualified personnel before the championships. The Classification Session will therefore be performed on Thursday 16th December 2022 (Friday) at the HQ Hotel, between 10:00 – 18:00.

A timetable for the classification session will be published after the registration online.

Attendance to the Classification Session is obligatory, without a participation in the such event it is not possible to take part in the championships.

Following documents have to be provided at the classification session:

- Accreditation of the athlete
- ID card or Passport of the athlete
- Original MDF as provided prior with the registration
- Original diagnostic Report as described in the MDF for Intellectual Impairments as provided with the registration

6.6.4. Coaches and personal assistants

Maximum of three coaches can be registered for Para-Karate per Nation.

Every Para-Karate athlete can be accompanied by a personal assistant during their







performance in the field of play.

Coaches and assistants accompanying Para-Karate athletes MUST register together with their delegation at the onsite registration session only.

All athletes must use the same sportswear and equipment for classification as they use during competitions.

Concerning athletes with visual impairments, no extra testing will be performed during the classification session. Nevertheless, the athletes have to show up to the classification with the documents and equipment mentioned above. Extra points will be given based on the Medical Diagnostic Form.

6.6.6. ANTI-DOPING

In compliance with WKF Anti-Doping Rules and WADA, Para-Karate athletes will be subject to any eventual testing. If any Para-Karate athlete would need a Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE), please contact your National Anti-Doping Organization for further details and recognition. The duly recognized TUE at national level will then have to be duly communicated to the WKF.
